CALL TO ACTION

- Implement & enforce eye protection where eye hazards eg. work sites
- Enforce prescription of shatter-resistant **polycarbonate lenses** for children, one-eyed patients, at risk individuals
- Eye care professionals to preach and practice preventive ophthalmology
- Institutions and medical centres to provide optimal primary and secondary eye trauma management through dedicated ophthalmic trauma units.
- National and regional ophthalmologic (including subspecialty) societies to work together in coordination
- Govt. and non-govt. organisations(NGOs) adopt and enforce policy with constant supervision.
